

BATTLE OF THE BANDS - MARCH 29, 1968

RULES FOR GROUPS

1. Combos will set up from LEFT to RIGHT. PLATFORMS MUST BE USED.
2. After combos finish they will remove their equipment and leave it alongside the stand.
3. Equipment will not be removed from the school until the winner has been announced. (This is to protect your equipment from loss).
4. NO special consideration will be given ANYONE to smoke.
5. The winning group will set up and play for dancing as soon as possible.
6. The program must end by 11 P.M.
7. Groups are to furnish their own extension cords.
8. Each group will receive 14 minutes from time they are introduced. A time clock will be set next to the playing group to gauge time.
9. It is expected that the scheduled groups will not cancel their commitment.
10. There is one award for 1st place - \$100.
- 11- 1st place winners of each contest will play in the run-offs on May 3rd, 1968. Prizes at that time will be: 1st place-\$200; 2nd place: \$100; 3rd place: \$50.
12. The top three winners on May 3rd will play for the summer block dance in July and August 1968, splitting 6 dances (2 each), hours 7:30 P.M. to 10:00 P.M. (\$50. per engagement). Vouchers are to be signed by leaders and then approved by Council).
13. Each group will be responsible for the protection of their equipment.

SPECIAL NOTE:

Guests of musicians nor band managers will be permitted to enter unless they pay admission. The awards are made from monies taken in at the door.

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
